This includes, but is not limited to, providing Emergency Medical Services and Fire Suppression to the community, assisting with budget preparation and grant development, assuming command at major incidents as needed, and providing other directly related assistance to the Fire Chief as required. The employee in this position must have the ability to quickly establish and maintain effective working relationships with the Fire Chief, other members of the Fire Department, the Town Manager, elected and appointed officials, other town employees, a variety of State, Federal, and local agencies, media representatives, and the public.

Qualifications and Skills

MINIMUM DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Possession of an Associate's Degree in Fire Science, Paramedicine, or in a closely related field; AND
- Considerable (10 years) progressively responsible experience in municipal firefighting, rescue, EMS, cause and origin investigation, fire prevention and education, including at least two years of supervisory experience; AND
- Paramedic Licensed, Firefighter II certified; AND
- Fire Officer Certification is desired, but not required;
- OR Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential duties of the position.
