The City of Sanford Maine will receive sealed bids from interested parties who wish to bid on the following items of surplus equipment which the Sanford Fire Department has to offer:

Item #1

- (1) One SCBA Cascade System with compressor, fill control panel, and (12) twelve storage bottles.

The system has a Bauer VT7-E3 High Pressure compressor (6/1969) 7CFM 5000 psi. This is a 3 phase unit which includes a "Kay Industries Phasemaster" rotary phase converter MA-2 (2-3 phase 240volts). Fill control panel and hoses has a (2) two place steel tube holder (not cabinet contained) Storage consists of (12) twelve 4500psi steel bottles.

Successful bidder shall be responsible for the removal of this equipment from the existing location at the Springvale Fire Station.

Item #2

- (1) One 1988 KME/International 1000/600 pumper. This truck is built on an all-wheel drive S-1800 35,000gvwr chassis. It has a 1000gpm Hale pump, 600 gallon water tank, (2) two booster reels, DT-466 diesel engine, approximately 43,048 miles, 6107 hours, 9' wide, 9' high, 25' long.

This truck is being replaced with a new vehicle purchased through an AFG Federal Grant and as a result cannot be sold to anyone intending to use it for emergency service response. **Successful bidder shall sign attesting this at the time of final sale.**

All bids must be sealed and delivered to the City of Sanford City Manager's office no later than January 5, 2018 at 1pm. At that time all sealed bids shall be opened, read aloud, and recorded. All bidders shall mark the envelope with the item # on it to reflect which item is being sought. The City of Sanford reserves the right to accept or reject any bid based on what is best for the City of Sanford. Upon award and cleared proper payment to the city, the successful bidder shall have (2) two weeks to remove the property from city storage unless alternative arrangements are made and accepted by the city. Payment in full will be coordinated through the City financial offices.
